

2007-08 Gridiron Club Projects



Within the last few years, the Gridiron Club has supported the Antigo Football teams by fundraising. Basic needs for the team can range anywhere from \$6,000 to 12,000 per year.

The members all agreed that Schofield Stadium, one of the Wisconsin Valley Conference's great football venues, was in need of major improvements. Beginning in 2007, The Antigo Gridiron Club undertook this major fundraising project, with a beginning goal of \$200,000. Working with the school board, it was agreed that all of the money had to be raised before it could become a reality.

Our community, along with former Antigo alumni and Antigo football fans came together and embraced this project. The fundraiser was a huge success. A 2000 square foot building has been built and includes new restroom facilities and a concession area. The building also houses a team meeting room (a "home") for our players and their coaches. The Gridiron Club will use the funds we have to finish the project and keep fundraising to continue making improvements to the stadium and field. The building will be ready for the 2008 season.

The Dedication of the Building will be held on Thursday, August 21 at the annual "Meet the Robins" kickoff to the season. The Robins travel to Wausau for a scrimmage the following day.
